On Wednesday, December 3, at 1:30 p.m. the Board will be provided with a tour of the WSIU Public Broadcasting Studio, 1100 Lincoln Drive, Carbondale, Illinois. Then, at 3:00 p.m., Stone Center, Office of the President, Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, Illinois, the Chair of the Board has called an executive session meeting of the Board of Trustees. The public portion of the meeting is expected to consist of a public comments and questions segment followed by a presentation by SIU students and a presentation by President Mahony titled *Intercollegiate Athletics: Past, Present and Future*. Following that it is expected that a motion will be made to close the meeting to the public for the purpose of considering pending, probable or imminent court proceedings against or on behalf of the Board; information regarding appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of employees or officers; and review of executive session minutes.

At 6:00 p.m., members of the Board of Trustees will attend dinner. The gathering is social in nature.

On Thursday, December 4, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., the Academic Matters Committee of the Board of Trustees will meet in the SIUC Student Center, Ballroom B, Lincoln Drive, Carbondale, Illinois. The meetings of the Audit, Finance and Architecture and Design Committees will immediately follow. Upon adjournment of the Architecture and Design Committee meeting, the regularly scheduled full Board meeting will convene. A news conference will be held in the Student Center immediately following the meeting.
