On Wednesday, July 8, at 3:00 p.m. in the Dirksen Conference Room, Medical Library, 801 North Rutledge, SIU School of Medicine, the Chair of the Board of Trustees has called an executive session meeting of the Board of Trustees. The public portion of the meeting will consist of a public comments and questions segment, a presentation by SIU students and an update from the SIU System AI Committee. Following that it is expected that a motion will be made to close the meeting to the public for the purpose of considering pending, probable or imminent court proceedings against or on behalf of the Board; information regarding appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of employees or officers; and review of executive session minutes.

At 6:00 p.m., members of the Board of Trustees will attend dinner. The gathering is social in nature.

On Thursday, July 9, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., the Board of Trustees will have breakfast with the President and Dr. Jerry Kruse, Dean and Provost of the SIU School of Medicine.

Following breakfast, at 9:00 a.m., the Academic Matters Committee of the Board of Trustees will meet in the Auditorium of the School of Medicine, 801 North Rutledge, Springfield, Illinois. The meetings of the Finance Committee and Architecture and Design Committee will immediately follow. Upon adjournment of the Architecture and Design Committee meeting, the regularly scheduled full Board meeting will convene. A news conference will be held in the Auditorium immediately following the meeting.
